

# RAISING THE ROOF

Hope House is a place of welcome, support and transformation for hundreds of people. It is also the distribution and administrative hub for 15 foodbanks across Nottingham. **But the roof is leaking in several places!!** The flat roof over the main church space and most of the pitched roofs need re-covering/re-tiling urgently. Whilst we have been seeking grant funding to address this, to date we have only £5000 out of the £35000 necessary. We need to ensure that the roof is repaired before this winter and before there is further deterioration. **Any support you can give would be very gratefully received.**

## 10% TO TUMAINI (HOPE) MUMIAS IN KENYA

In February we were delighted to welcome to Hope House, Bishop Joseph Wandera of the diocese of Mumias, Kenya. The Bishop has a vision to establish a project similar to Hope House in Mumias, to serve those who are homeless and disadvantaged. Since then we have had the honour of providing guidance via Skype to Bishop Joseph and his team. As a result they are planning to launch their project in September. The project will be based in a disused building next to Mumias Cathedral. This building requires about ten thousand dollars-worth of improvements to enable the project to proceed.
